he pandemic, economic collapse, political crisis and protests around the globe are signs of a fainting world, wrapped in darkness making people plunging into deep sadness and hopelessness. The recent occurrences in the world have put people in fear, expecting the next worse scenario. Life can be very exhausting. Physical and emotional distress set in when pursuing our goals. The race

is not for the faint hearted. "To this day we are aware of the universal agony and groaning of creation, as if it were in the contractions of labor for childbirth", (Rom. 8:22 (TPT)).

A fainting soul despised the most valuable asset of his life

just physical fainting, but also famishing of the soul and weak spirit. He demanded for the birthright. Just like a fainting man had lost strength to fight back, so did Esua. He was too weak to resist, neither could he turn down the request, nor understood the implication of

Just as Esua traded away his

It is possible to be physically strong and able, but the soul is weak and the spirit is fainted. When Jesus was confronted by the agony of the cross, He said: "Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak", (Matt. 26:41). Although, Jesus was bodily drained, but with a sound mind and willing spirit, He defied the weakness and triumphed over all oppositions.

Weariness and faint heartedness affect people of all ages. "Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall", (Isa. 40:30). Both young and old are ambitious about life, facing unimaginable temptations and insurmountable experiences; however, "If you fall apart during a crisis, then you weren't very strong to begin with",

(Prov. 24:10 (VOICE)).

The word "faint" appeared first in the Bible in connection to Esua. "And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field,

and he was faint", (Gen. 25:29 (KJV)). In fact, the first and second occasions related to Esua. "And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called Edom", (Gen. 25:30 (KJV)). Esua returned from hunting famished, wearied, weak and fainted. He may be hungry, starving and thirsty, however, as the elder brother, he had the right to everything in the house, but because he fainted, he

right to blessing, so can anybody whose soul is famished. When Jacob demanded for the birthright, what was the response of the fainting soul? "And Esau said, "Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?"" (Gen. 25:32). Esua surrendered his birthright and faced the eternal consequences. A fainting soul despised the most valuable asset of his life. Your birthright is your right to inheritance with special privileges. It is the mantle to lead your generation. It gives access to generational blessings. However good and hardworking you are, gaining access to blessing makes you much more profitable. Regardless of your position in the family, your birthright is your mantle to unblock favor and rise above your generational limitation.

lost consciousness of his right, hence, he begged for what was his. Only asked for food but Jacob

responded with a deeper interpretation of the

situation. "But Jacob said, "Sell me your birthright as of this day"", (Gen. 25:31). Jacob discerned not

his action.

What could be the possible reasons for Esua to be

so fainted that he lost his birthright? "But the children struggled together within her; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the LORD"", (Gen. 25:22).

The struggle for birthright between Esua and Jacob began from the womb. At birth Jacob was holding on tightly to the heel of Esua. "Afterward his brother came out, and his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them", (Gen. 25:26). However, both children were exposed to equal opportunities growing up. "As Jacob and Esau grew older, Esau liked the outdoors and became a good hunter, while Jacob settled down and became a shepherd", (Gen. 25:27 (CEV)). As the boys grew, Esua patterned his life contrary to the family heritage and chose a wrong role model. He became a hunter after the order of Nimrod. "He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, "Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD"", (Gen. 10:9). As Nimrod's empire perished, so did Esua's. A fainting soul follows a wrong path and chooses an unprofitable lifestyle. But Jacob focused

on heritage sustained by eternal covenant.

The growing child in the womb searches for significance, security, acceptance, love and

appreciation. Even after birth the search for meaning and purpose continues. But a fainting soul easily gets diverted and pursues things that lack enduring success.

Jonah was another man who was sent on a mission, but fainted. He said "When my soul fainted within me, I remembered the LORD; And my prayer went up to You, Into Your holy temple", (Jonah 2:7). "And it happened, when the sun arose, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat

on Jonah's head, so that he grew faint. Then he wished death for himself, and said, "It is better for me to die than to live", (Jonah 4:8). Jonah fainted when he acted contrary to the Divine assignment, ""Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me." But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the LORD. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and went down into it, to go with them to

Tarshish from the presence of the LORD", (Jonah1:2-4). With a contradicting mind set, Jonah "paid the fare" to a stormy voyage.

A fainting man is a drowning

man with a confused mind trapped with fear desiring fresh breath to recover from the weeds wrapped around his head (Jonah 2:5). Truly speaking, many people need to disentangle their minds from fear, doubt, bitterness, lust, greed and pride. These could cause so much frustration and heaviness of the mind resulting to shipwreck of the soul.

Gideon was the man considered to "... faint, yet

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pursuing", (Judges 8:4). Exhausted and famished but not losing hope. It is therefore possible to be overwhelmed and troubled but not given up. Tired, but not losing focus. In the days of Gideon, Israel was under the captivity of Midian for seven years. Midian means "strife". "And the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel ...", (Judges 6:2). Simply put, "strife prevailed against Israel".

"For wherever there is jealousy (envy) and contention (rivalry and selfish ambition), there will also be confusion (unrest, disharmony, rebellion) and all sorts of evil and vile practices", (James 3:16 (AMPC)). Never be overpowered by hostility and

discord. Quarrelling and offenses can be very draining. They are power leakers. Just as the Israelites hid themselves in dens and caves because of the Midianites, even so are

many people hidden and their glory undiscovered.

When strife (Midian) prevailed, what were the consequences?

- Their harvest was invaded (Judges 6:3).
- "And they encamped against them ...", (v4) A life style of strife incites troubles and prevents you from flourishing in your true identity.
- "... and destroyed the increase of the earth", (v4) – A fainting man decreases in energy and productivity. Fainting spirit makes people live unprofitable life.
- "... and left no substance for Israel ...", (v4) Nothing is spared when fainting spirit sets in. A fainting man loses grip of what is holding on to, however valuable it may be.
- "... and they entered into the land to destroy it", (v5) – When strife gains entrance into any life, it opens the door to numerous tormenting spirits; they come "with their tents", "as grasshoppers for multitude", (v5).

"So Israel was greatly impoverished because of the Midianites, and the children of Israel cried out to the LORD", (Judges 6:6). When (Midian) strife prevailed against Israel: - "So Israel became poverty-stricken", (CSB)

- "So Israel became very weak ...", (CEB)
- "Israel became very discouraged ...", (CJB)
- "Israel became very poor ...", (ERV)
- "And Israel was helpless against them", (GNT)
- "And Israel was brought very low ...", (RSV)

When God raised-up Gideon to lead his people out of the oppression, He addressed him from the position of strength, looking beyond his weakness. "And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, "The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor!"" (Judges 6:12). But Gideon responded from a fainting soul. "Gideon said to Him, "O my

> lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His miracles which our fathers told us about, saying, 'Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt?' But now the

LORD has forsaken us and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites", (Judges 6:13). Hear the cry of a fainting man (v13) "if", "why", "then", "where", "did not", "but", "forsaken" and "handed over". A fainting man will always express doubts, regrets and failure. Nonetheless, the angel did not change his stand on making Gideon to arise in strength. "Then the LORD turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?"" (Judges 6:14).'

Gideon was also concerned about the wretchedness of his family. "So he said to Him, "O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house"", (Judges 6:15). After this encounter Gideon built an altar unto the Lord and name it "Jehovah Shalom" (v24) – "The Lord is peace". "The Lord calms our fears". The peace of God calms our fears and revives us from fainting. "And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross", (Col. 1:20).

David, the King of Israel was a valiant warrior yet he fainted. "Moreover the Philistines had yet war

It is therefore possible to be overwhelmed and troubled but not given up

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again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint. And Ishbibenob, which was of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear weighed three hundred shekels of brass in weight, he being girded with a new sword, thought to have slain David. But Abishai the son of Zeruiah succoured him. and smote the Philistine. and killed him. Then the men of David sware unto him, saying, Thou shalt go no more out with us to

battle, that thou guench not the light of Israel", (2 Sam. 21:15-17 (KJV)).

"... and David waxed faint", (v15). What caused the fainting? David fainted because, "the Philistine had

yet war again with Israel". The Philistine having been defeated over and over again never gave up. So repeated warfare and persistent attacks can cause the people to faint. This time, "David went down", (v15). The approach and the strategy of warfare was a downward path of defeat.

"... and his servants with him". When David went down, his men also went down with him. Leaning upon a fainting man brings everybody to the ditch. Do not heed to fainting spirit, it influences people around you to be as weak as you. When David became weak, one of the sons of the giants, "Ishbibenob", (v16), rose up against him to smite. The adverse effect of not working on our weaknesses is that, it produces giants out of adversaries.

It is time to acknowledge our weaknesses and actively work on overcoming and turning them to success.

When Saul and his men of war could not war against the Philistines, a giant confronted them day and night. He defiled the ranks of Israel till they lost courage and very terrified.

Nobody could challenge him until David rose up to rescue Israel from the reproach. While the people were petrified with the size and how Goliath was arrayed for battle, David looked past the giant and saw the mightiness of the God of Israel establishing

victory. David, the same David who defeated Goliath could not overcome another giant because he waxed faint. Comparing the two giants, Goliath and Ishbibenob. "And there went out a

champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span. And he had an helmet of brass upon his head, and he was armed with a coat of mail; and the weight of the coat was five thousand shekels of brass. And he had greaves of brass upon his legs, and a target of brass between his shoulders. And the staff of his spear was like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head weighed six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him", (1 Sam. 17:4-7(KJV)). "Then Ishbi-Benob, who was one of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose bronze spear was three hundred shekels, who was bearing a new sword, thought he could kill David", (2 Sam 21:16).

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Goliath was stronger and well equipped for battle. Goliath's spear head weighed "600 Shekels of iron" while Ishibibenob's spear head weighed "300 Shekels of brass". Goliath's spear head was stronger and harder, yet he was defeated by David. But when David fainted, the giant with an inferior weapon almost killed him. When we are full of strength, we can overcome the strongest giant, but when we are weak and faint hearted even the weakest weapon can bring us down.

It is time to acknowledge our weaknesses and actively work on overcoming and turning them to success. Who was the giant that rose up against David when he fainted? Ishbibenob. His name means: "dweller on the mount". The wicked always want to gain an advantaged height to monitor our

advancement. Even though David was a King, nonetheless, his adversary dwelling on the mountain looked down on his royalty, despised his achievements, watching for the right time to invade.

Ishbibenob was "girded with a new sword", (v16). A new sword (weapon) – improved, redesigned, advanced and distinct. With this new sword, "he thought to have slain David", (v16).

Repeated battles are not just another battle, rather an improved, redesigned, advance and distinct from previous battles. Persistent problems, if not resolved get twisted and complex. At David's weakest moments, "Abishai" came to his rescue (v17). Abishai means "father of a gift". A father is considered as a ruler of a generation. So, David received not just an ordinary help in his weakness, but the help that rules. May we receive help that rules over the oppressors and their oppression. Abishai was an ideal gift. A suitable gift, so generously lavished to a fainting man. Neglect not your own gifts. Stir it up, fan to flame, rekindle and

bring your gifts to blazing fire. Use and grow your gifts (1 Tim. 4:14; 2 Tim. 1:6) Hence, David's men told him "You shall go out no more with us to battle, lest you quench the lamp of Israel", (v17). David got true help that will fight the rest of his battles. Persistent conflict is intended to break our defenses, put people in darkness and extinguish their burning lamp.

Do not allow fainting spirit to quench your light. A fainting soul expresses despondency with wrong approaches to life. "Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart. But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves

to every man's conscience in the sight of God", (2 Cor. 4:1-2). "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth,

Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint", (Isa. 40:28-31).

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
