
ISRAEL TOUR 2023 "VICTORY AT JERICHO"

EXPERIENCE THE GOSPEL

Day 1 -Sunday, November 19: TORONTO

Departure from Toronto (Terminal 1) on Air Canada flying non-stop to Tel Aviv departing at 4:50pm

Day 2 -Monday, November 20: TEL AVIV/ JAFFA

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 10:15am where our tour guide will meet you. After departing the airport, we travel to **Jaffa**, which affords us a breathtaking view of the city of Tel Aviv. At this picturesque port city of winding alleys, art galleries and crafts boutiques, King Solomon had the cedars of Lebanon rafted for the building of the First Temple in Jerusalem. You will view the spot of the House of Simon the Tanner (Acts 10:6). Transfer to our hotel for check-in and the balance of the day is at leisure to enjoy Tel Aviv and catch up on your jet lag. **Dinner and overnight at the Metropolian Hotel, Tel Aviv**

Day 3—Tuesday, November 21: CAESAREA/MT. CARMEL/ MEGIDDO

We drive north along the Plain of Sharon, the Mediterranean and the old coastal road- the Via Maris that linked Egypt and Babylon as we journey towards Galilee. We stop at Caesarea the incredible fortress city built by King Herod the Great. Here, Pontius Pilate had his base; where Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); where Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30) and where Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City. We continue to Mt. Carmel the site where the prophet Elijah fought the 400 false prophets of Baal. Visit the Cave of Elijah the Prophet on Mt. Carmel. Elijah the Prophet is arguably the most famous of the Biblical prophets. This was one of the most sacred caves in the Holy Land. According to Jews and Christians, this was one of the places where the Prophet Elijah lived and hid 29 centuries ago. We turn inland to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's walled fortified cites with ruins of 20 levels of civilizations. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelations will come alive as we read the final Battle of Armageddon. Continue to Tiberias and the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

Day 4 - Wednesday, November 22: JESUS MINISTRY IN THE GALILEE

After breakfast, we will depart our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Kibbutz Ginossar where we will see an ancient boat from the time of Jesus displayed at the Kibbutz Museum. Continue to Capernaum, the centre of Jesus' Galilean ministry and the site of many of his miracles. We will see the remains of Peter's house and the synagogue site where Jesus taught and worshipped. Continue to the Church of the Primacy the site which commemorates Jesus reinstatement of Peter after a fish breakfast on the shore. Drive to Tabgha and visit the Church of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered what is perhaps the most famous sermon ever preached – "The Sermon On the Mount" (Matt.5). Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

Day 5---Thursday, November 23: GALILEE

We will drive north to Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River and the site of ancient "Caesarea Philipi", where Peter made the confession of faith in Christ (Matt; 16:16). Continue to Tel Dan one of the most important sites for the archaeological and historical recovery of ancient Israel. The city of Dan represented the northern border of the biblical kingdom of Israel. Drive to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus for a panoramic view of the city. We will visit Nazareth Village depicting a village from the time of Jesus. Return to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

Day 6 - Friday, November 24: JERICHO/TIMNA PARK/ EILAT ON THE RED SEA

We drive through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the oldest city in the world conquered by Joshua for a visit. Visit the Tel of Jericho and see the oldest tower in the world and the Sycamore Tree. We stop at the Baptismal Site on the Jordan River (Qasr El-Yahud). Continue driving along the shores of the Dead Sea and Arava Valley to Timna Park the site of the world's first copper mine where is thousands of ancient mining shafts from the time of ancient imperial Egypt. Also we will see the Reconstructed Tabernacle and the replica of the altar. We finish the day in the beautiful resort town of Eilat on the Red Sea. Dinner and overnight at the Astral Village Hotel, Eilat.

Day 7---Saturday, November 25: EILAT (RED SEA)

Today is a day of leisure in Eilat to enjoy this resort town on the Red Sea. Take a swim in the Red Sea or enjoy snorkeling or diving to see the amazing coral and tropical fish. The Red Sea is considered one of the best places in the world for diving. You can go to the Underwater Observatory and aquarium. Dinner and overnight at the Astral Village Hotel, Eilat

Day 8 – Sunday, November 26: MASADA/ DEAD SEA/ JERUSALEM

After breakfast we drive north to the lowest point on earth the Dead Sea that is over 1300 feet below sea level to Masada. You will take a cable car to the summit of this magnificent fortress built by King Herod the Great and the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots. Visit the historic ruins and see the palaces, bathhouses, swimming pool, and the oldest synagogue in the world on this mountain in the middle of the desert. After descending this mountain by cable car we travel to the shores of the Dead Sea where you will have time to take a float in the saltiest body of water in world. We visit the Ahava Factory that sells all the various Dead Sea products. Continue to the oasis of Ein Gedi Nature Reserve a Garden of Eden in the desert to see the waterfall. Drive to Jerusalem via the Judean Wilderness. Dinner & overnight at the Royal Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 9--- Monday, November 27: JERUSALEM/VALLEY OF ELAH/ VALLEY OF AYALON

We start the day at the Mount of Olives, for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. We continue to visit the Pools of Bethesda, St. Anne's Church. We drive to the newly excavated City of David including the Pool of Siloam and Hezekiah Tunnel. Walk to the Davidson Centre and visit the archaeological park of the excavations along the Western and Southern walls of the Temple Mount of Jerusalem. We drive to the Elah Valley where the biblical battle between David & Goliath took place. Continue to the The Valley of Ayalon first mentioned in the Book of Joshua as where Joshua defeated five Amorite kings. Following his midnight march to rescue the city of Gibeon from the coalition led by the King of Jebus (Jerusalem), Joshua pursued the coalition eastward, down through the descent of Beth-Horon, and then southward across the Valley of Ajalon. To allow the Israelites to complete the rout before nightfall, Joshua asked the Lord to lengthen the day by uttering the command: "Sun, stand thou still on Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Aijalon". Joshua 10:11-14 records that God cooperated with Joshua's request. Dinner & overnight at the Royal Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 10 - Tuesday, November 28: JERUSALEM/ SHILO/BETHLEHEM

We start the day with a drive to Shilo the site of the Tabernacle and the first capital of the Israelite Kingdom, is one of the most importance heritage sites in Israel, with a history of 3,000 years. The layers of the different historical periods present the story of the region and its people. Here, the biblical stories of its original inhabitants - Samuel the prophet, Hanna and her famous prayer for a child. Return to Jerusalem to the Jewish Quarter of the Old City for a visit to the visit the Temple Institute which tells the story of the Holy Temple in words and pictures. It is a story that spans the millennia, from the beginning of creation, to the establishment of the Third Holy Temple, as foretold by every prophet of Israel. We exit the Old City at the Zion Gate and we visit Mt Zion to visit the traditional site of the Upper Room (Room of the Last Supper), King David's Tomb and the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu, built on top of the High Priest Caiphas' house. Drive to Bethlehem and visit the Church of the Nativity, the oldest church in the world and birthplace of Jesus and Shepherds Field. Return to your hotel. We finish the day with a visit to the Garden Tomb or Gordon's Calvary for a communion service before returning to your hotel. Dinner and overnight at the Royal Hotel, Jerusalem


Day11 - Wednesday November 29: JERUSALEM

After breakfast, enjoy a day of leisure. Perhaps re-visit the Old City for shopping in the bazaars or to the new city for shopping along Jaffa Road and Ben Yehuda Street. Visit many of the Museums that Jerusalem has to offer that you did not see on the tour. Dinner and overnight at the Royal Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 12—Thursday, November 30: CANADA

Depart the hotel after breakfast to the airport for your non-stop flight with Air Canada departing at 11:55am and arriving Toronto's Terminal 1 at 5:00pm.
